

Guests were welcomed by a live Hawaiian music band and light refreshments by a world-class Chef.



Construction is now underway at the future site of Kalakaua Gardens, a \$75 million development located at 1723 Kalakaua Avenue. The 17-story long-term, kupuna living community will house more than 200 residents and create about 300 jobs in the construction phase of the project and just under 200 jobs in the health-care/facility management phase.

Currently, Avalon Health Care Group is seeking applicants to provide for the healthcare needs of future residents. Interested nurses, nurses aids, physical therapists and more are being sought for the project which is slated to be complete in late 2015.

Developed by Island Paradise Investments and managed by Avalon Health Care Group, the project will create 136 assisted living units, 49 skilled-nursing beds, 23 memory-care units and the community features a state-of-the-art rehabilitation center.

The special groundbreaking ceremony will feature a traditional Hawaiian blessing and special guest U.S. Sen. Mazie Hirono.
